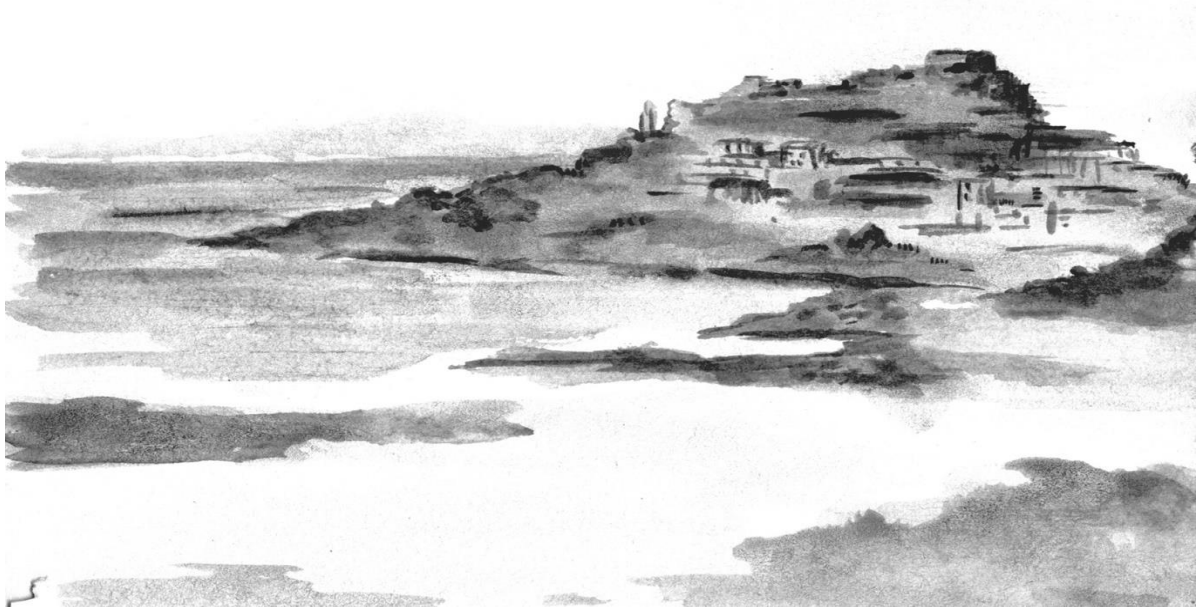

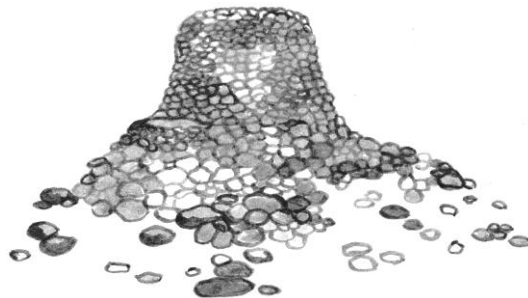

Italian wines classification

DOCG: The highest classification for Italian wines, introduced in 1980. It is used to ensure that a wine is controlled and above all follows a predetermined production scheme outside of which it would no longer receive the aforementioned denomination, which is guaranteed by the initials as an index of superior quality. There are strict rules regarding the production of DOCG wines, most of them inherent to the type of grape allowed for production, the yield limits, the ripening of the grapes, the vinification procedures and the specific aging. Each DOCG wine is subject to official tasting procedures. To prevent counterfeiting, the bottles have a numbering that seals the neck of the bottle. A wine will be able to obtain the DOCG only if it has been included in the DOC for at least 10 years.

DOC: A step below DOCG and created in 1963, it is part of the classification inherent in most of the wines produced in Italy. Quality control standards are less strict (but similar in style) than those applied to DOCG wines.

IGT classification was introduced in 1992, to allow a certain level of freedom to Italian winemakers. Before 1992, many wines did not qualify under the DOC or DOCG terms not because they were of low quality, but because they were made from grape varieties (or blends) not sanctioned under DOC or DOCG. The IGT classification focuses on the region of origin, instead of grapes conforming to the varieties or styles of the wine under consideration.

VdT are wines generally of lower quality; no requirement is established, other than to be a healthy wine. The color and alcohol content will simply be expressed on the label.

Italian

Beer in Italy was known since the seventh century BC being traded to Sicily by Phoenician merchants. Romans also produced but small quantity of beers as they preferred wines instead. Until the mid-nineteenth century beer was consumed by a few enthusiasts as it was completely foreign to local tradition. We need waiting until mid-twenty century for beer to become in effect a product of common use.

Beer, being the third most popular drink after water and tea, is also one of the most widely consumed alcoholic drinks in the world. The earliest evidence of beer production from barley comes from Iran and dates back approximately to the third century BC. Beer is measured and assessed by bitterness, strength and color using the IBU (International Bitterness Unit) scale.

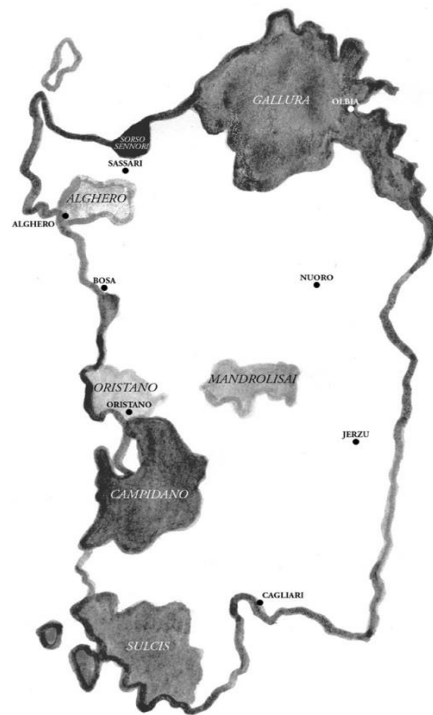

Sardinia

Sardinia is the second largest island in the Mediterranean and is 200 kilometres off Italy's west coast. It is a unique region that has spent much of its recent history under Spanish rules. The Phoenicians were Sardinia's first foreign invaders and introduced winemaking to the island, but it was the Spanish, controlling the island from the 14th to 18th centuries, who contributed the most to Sardinia's wine production. The climate is Mediterranean, with short, mild, wet winters and long, hot, dry summers. With rugged mountains and dry plains, soil types vary from sandy clays in the south, the granite of Gallura in the north, to alluvial, gravelly soils around Oristano in the west. Today Sardinia is home to a unique range of grape varieties, predominantly of Spanish origin. Previously known for producing bulk, fortified and 'Meditazione' wines (including the famous Vernaccia di Oristano from the west coast), Sardinia is now known for its high-quality table wine from Vermentino, Cannonau and Carignano. Beyond these, lay an exciting range of lesser-known varieties such as Nuragus, Torbato, Monica and Bovale, adding diversity and interest to the Sardinian range.



Sardinian sparkling wines

In Sardinia sparkling wines are produced from a variety of local and international grapes (if only in fairly small quantities) and can be dry or sweet. Tenute Olbios and Quartomoro make a sparkling wine in the 'Metodo Classico' (Champagne method) with Sella e Mosca and Su Entu using the Charmat (Tank) method.

This vigorous vine, suitable for various breeding systems, ensures a constant and generous production, expressing the essence of the Mediterranean. Vermentino is used for the production of Vermentino di Gallura being the only Sardinian wine to be awarded the DOCG, the highest Italian wine classification.

Torbato

Of undoubtedly Spanish origin, it is in Sardinia that Torbato was able to reveal its full potential, specifically in the Alghero region characterized by a warm and dry climate and by calcareous-clayey soils, rich in sand and iron, which give the wines strength and minerality. Torbato is generally vinified in purity and as a base for a sparkling wine (both Traditional and Charmat Method), both comprised in the DOC Alghero. Great with lobster Catalana, try with bottarga, sea urchin, seafood and spicy dishes.

Granazza is the local name for the same grape around the area of Nuoro in the centre of the island. Great with bottarga.

Semidano

Very unique to Sardinia, Semidano is a vine with a rather scarce and inconsistent production, being able to produce wines of excellent quality. It has survived almost exclusively in the Oristano province (sub-area of Mogoro), a territory of hills of calcareous origin mixed with sands, which enjoy the benefits of the Mediterranean climate and the mistral. In 1995 the DOC Sardegna Semidano was established, including sparkling, superior and passito version. It generally suits all seafood cuisine.

Nuragus

Nuragus still is the most widely grown variety in Sardinia although mainly present in the provinces of Cagliari and Oristano. Grape of ancient origin it has been favored by the extreme ease of cultivation and adaptability to any type of soil. Since 1975 the vine has its own denomination, the Nuragus di Cagliari DOC, also in the sparkling and sweet versions. Dry or sweet, it can be paired with fried fish, crustaceans or molluscs, but also with tasty soups, always based on fish.

Nasco

Grape of ancient origin whose name derives from the Latin 'muscus', to describe the characteristic musky aroma of the refined wines, Nasco was on the brink of extinction and saved by a group of zealous growers from the province of Cagliari which in time also managed to obtain the DOC - Nasco di Cagliari. There are no reports of Nasco vines outside of Sardinia, making this variety exclusive to the Mediterranean Islands where grows almost solely on the calcareous soil of Campidano di Cagliari. Its grapes can be used to produce wines in dry (secco), sweet (dolce), fortified (liquoroso) styles with musky tropical flavours. Dry versions can be consumed with rich fish and white meat dishes while sweet one is a real treat with local sweet and cheeses.

Cannonau

Cannonau is the most widespread black grape variety in Sardinia and certainly the best known outside the island. It is grown throughout the region, although the greatest concentration is found in the central areas, in particular in the Nuorese and Ogliastra. The DOC was recognized in 1972. For a long time it was believed that Cannonau was originally from the Iberian Peninsula (Garnacha); however: some important archaeological finds have made it possible to confirm that nuraghic populations cultivated vines and produced wine from an ancestor grape of Cannonau. It is great with suckling pig and game dishes. Styles range from medium-bodied and soft, to rich, supple and powerful.

Cagnulari

Cagnulari or Cagliunari, is a red grape variety mainly grown in the north-western area of Sardinia. Recent studies have highlighted similarities with Graciano (Rioja-Spain) and Bovale Sardo, another native Sardinian variety; it would therefore be the fruit of a cross between these two varieties. It is a complicated variety which has found its ideal habitat in loose alluvial soils not far from the sea and whose sensitivity to various climatic factors requires careful and constant work in the vineyard as well as in the cellar. Drinks well with meat dishes.

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Bovale

Bovale (also known as Nieddera or Muristellu/Muristeddu) is related to the French Mourvedre and Spanish Monastrell. 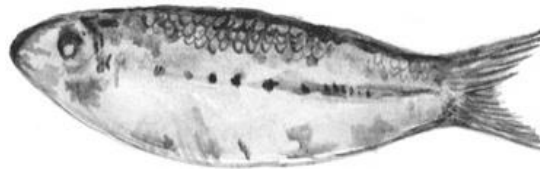

Orange Wines

Orange wines are created when white wine grapes are treated like red grapes and skins are left in contact with the must during fermentation: the longer the contact the deeper the colour of the wine. Orange wines are generally but not necessarily related to natural or biodynamic practises, often aged in underground amphorae or wooden barrels and bottled without any filtration. For an untrained palate, they can be surprising but also disconcerting, as they are not comparable to any modern white wines.

At present there is no governing body setting rules for the production of orange wines.

Grappe and Acqueviti

Grappe - 30ML

Grappa is a brandy made by distilling the pomace (or marc) of grapes after they have been pressed for their juice.

Grappa is traditionally produced in Northern Italy. There is a legend that tells of a Roman soldier who first distilled grappa in the Bassano del Grappa-Veneto using distilling equipment stolen in Egypt ("Crisiopea di Cleopatra" 2nd century AD). However distillation useful for producing beverages was not discovered in the Middle East until the eighth century, taking at least another two more centuries to travel to Italy (possibly by route of the Crusades).
